Re: Headteacher vacancy at All Saints' Catholic Voluntary Academy

As you know, the school's current Headteacher, Mr Paul Greig will be leaving All Saints' at the end of the academic year to take up a position in Nottingham. We have recently advertised for a replacement Headteacher and earlier in the week a shortlisting panel met to review the applications. It is my job, as CEO designate for the new Our Lady of Lourdes Catholic Multi-Academy Trust, to ensure the very best provision for all the students at All Saints'. The senior leadership team, and in particular the Headteacher, are crucial to ensuring the very best Catholic education for your children.
