Getting Yourself Examination Year Ready

RE		Students will be working on the RS PixL independent study work booklet. This involves multiple choice questions, followed by short answer questions, a wider reading task and two evaluation exam style questions.
English		Task 1) Gain at least 1,000 extra points on the PiXL Literature app, studying A Christmas Carol, Blood Brothers and Macbeth. Task 2) Create at least 6 essay plans for comparing poems from the anthology.
Maths		Students will be given 4 personalised topics to cover from MyMaths; this will be assigned using their latest mock exam. Students will make notes, using a template, then work through the online homework.
Science		Using the youtube link watch the video clips about the required practical. Then complete the corresponding revision sheet. History		Use of Pixl APP for knowledge low stakes testing. AWN and LSS's sets will complete two questions on Weimar unit and two questions on Elizabethan England. OVY and GMN's set will be completing a range of work on Elizabethan England.

Design and Technology:		Your Summer homework will be focusing on the NEA. This involves working on section A and will include work based on; researching existing products and the design specification. The modelled work will be on the VLE for you to access exemplar work. Save to memory stick or / email the work to yourself for putting into the NEA first week back in September.
Food and Nutrition:		The summer homework will be focusing on key understanding of the food concepts needed to access the NEA and examination. This work will be on the VLE where students can access all sections of work that needs to be completed for first week back in September.
Computing		Students are to complete an exam questions booklet tailored to their needs, this will cover the areas highlighted in the recent mock exams. This is to help prepare students for paper 1 Computer systems and paper 2 Computational thinking, algorithms and programming. Students are also required to complete online coding tasks here progress will be recorded to prepare them for their programming project in year 11.
