Reminders/information:

- **Year 11 Revision- Seneca** - A revision page has been created for our students on Seneca. Students have been emailed a link but they can also sign up by clicking [here](#). This is a free resource and there are 48 courses students can access to revise and self-quiz. Currently, 66 students in year 11 have joined the group and have completed over 170 hours of private study, answering over 18,000 questions, averaging 88% correct answers. Students simply need to sign-up and log-in to gain access to this incredible resource.
