GENERAL NOTICES

Lifting of Restrictions: Guidance for Churches was recently received from the Catholic Bishops' Conference of England and Wales. Based on this guidance the following decisions were made following recent meetings with Parish Pastoral Councils and Community Core Groups. There is no longer a need to book for Mass. From the first weekend of Lent (5/6 March) there will be no formal social distancing in our Church buildings. However, we ask that you be sensitive to the needs of others around you. The use of hymn books can be resumed and we will enjoy singing together once again.

The reception of Holy Communion is returned to the correct practice of parishioners approaching the Sanctuary down the centre aisle. Please wait for greeters to direct you to join the Communion line. Please be assured the Priest and Eucharistic Minister will continue to bring Communion to those less able. We appreciate there still needs to be caution taken for your own and everyone's safety. We recommend you continue to wear a face covering and use the hand sanitiser provided on entering and leaving church.

Greeters will continue to be present at all our celebrations to welcome you on arrival, to direct you when receiving Holy Communion and to take the collection as you leave the church. As caring parish communities, we welcome these changes as we move forward with hope for the future.
