Churches Together: Open meeting of Churches Together in Mansfield in St Philip Neri Church hall on Monday 21 March at 7.30pm

From the Salesians - Since launching our fundraising appeal for the crisis in Ukraine over £20,000 has been raised for the work of the Salesians working in Ukraine and surrounding areas that are helping the refugees fleeing the conflict.

The Solemnity of the Annunciation: On Friday, 25 March during the celebration of Penance at 5.00pm in St Peter's, Pope Francis will consecrate Russia and Ukraine to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. We will join with Pope Francis by praying the Joyful Mysteries of the Rosary after the Stations of the Cross in St Philip Neri and after evening Mass in St Joseph's.

Update from the Salesians in Poland -

Since the attacks on Ukraine began on 24/02/22 help has been provided through the Salesians and Salesian Sisters working in Ukraine who have not left the country at this difficult time. The Salesians in Poland are offering shelter to many refugees from Ukraine and to students from other countries fleeing the war through Poland. They also mediate in finding accommodation. They organise medical, psychological and legal assistance. Over 1 million people have fled from Ukraine to Poland. No refugee camp has been set up, all of them are being taken in by Polish families. The Salesians have managed to prepare several hundred places in their homes. Salesian volunteers in the country are helping to collect, segregate and distribute gifts, to welcome refugees and to transport people and goods to Ukraine. They also organise lessons and take care of Ukrainian children, to facilitate their adaptation to the new reality in Poland.
