

<u>DEANERY ORGANISATION</u>: You may be aware that there has been a good deal of consultation happening in the Diocese with regard to the need to look at the number of priests and the number of Churches. The Sherwood Deanery has already had some changes with regards to parishes losing their resident priest. A further meeting of the PPCs and Core Groups has been arranged for **Tuesday, 24th May**. We will keep you informed of progress and any changes that will need to be made further to those we have already experienced.

<u>EUCHARISTC MINISTERS RENEWAL DAY:</u> This will take place on **Saturday, 18th June** at the Becket School, Wilford Lane, West Bridgford, Nottingham. Bishop Patrick will be saying Mass and leading a reflection.

<u>FOOD BANK:</u> There is a crisis at the foodbank because the number of people needing the emergency rations that the foodbank can offer has doubled recently. At the same time, donations have dramatically decreased. All the donations that I take each week soon disappear off the shelves. Also, the first Ukrainian refugees have come to the foodbank seeking help, so the foodbank is very grateful for your generous donations of goods and cash. We need tinned hot and cold meat, tinned fish, tinned vegetables, coffee, tinned fruit, toiletries, cleaning materials and nappies. Thank you very much. for your continued support.
