To request a password for GO 4 Schools, please click on 'First-time User?' and enter your email address and click 'New password'. You will receive an email from Go 4 Schools, please follow the link in the email to set your password. You will then be able to log into the site and view your child's page.

What you will see on the Mobile App

Timetable detail:

You are then presented with today's timetable. You can tap or swipe to previous and future days at the top.



Attendance:

From the main screen scroll down to view attendance information. A chart displays the overall percentage attendance.




The App will also display detail about specific attendance marks including authorised and unauthorised attendance marks. Late marks are incorporated into the overall attendance marks and unknown marks are waiting for confirmation of the reason for the absence. NOTE: There are two possible sessions in a

school day, AM and PM.



Attainment:

Scrolling down further, you can see the attainment card, showing how your child is doing in their subjects. The attainment card at the top level provides their grades, and their residual (how well they are doing when compared to their target), if shared by their school.
