

VICAR GENERAL FOR THE DIOCESE OF NOTTINGHAM: Bishop Patrick has announced that Canon John Kyne will be appointed one of two Vicars-General for the Diocese with effect from Easter Monday the 10th April. He will succeed Canon Joe Wheat who has served a five year term of office and who has asked to stand down. The Vicars-General are the Bishop's principal advisors and Canon John will have a particular responsibility for the counties of Nottinghamshire and Derbyshire. Canon Eddy Jarosz will continue as Vicar-General responsible for Lincolnshire and Leicestershire. This new post will mean that Canon John will need to be away from the parish more frequently on Diocesan business. As a parish we are grateful to Frs Marc and Shalbin and Sr Susan for pastoral ministry across our parishes, in our schools, and in our hospital.
