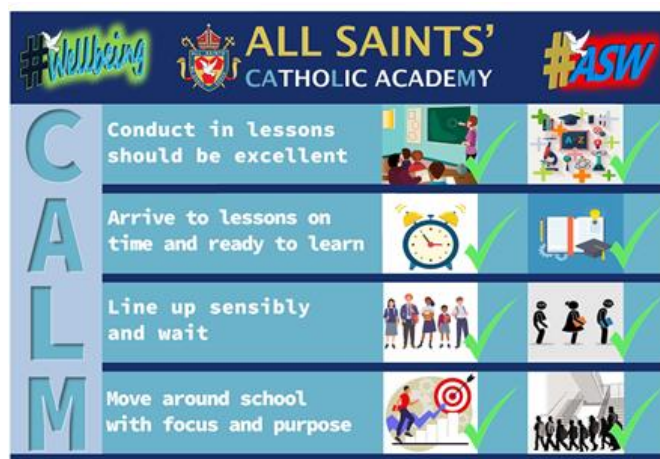
All Saints' Way - This week's All Saints' way theme continues to be Serve!

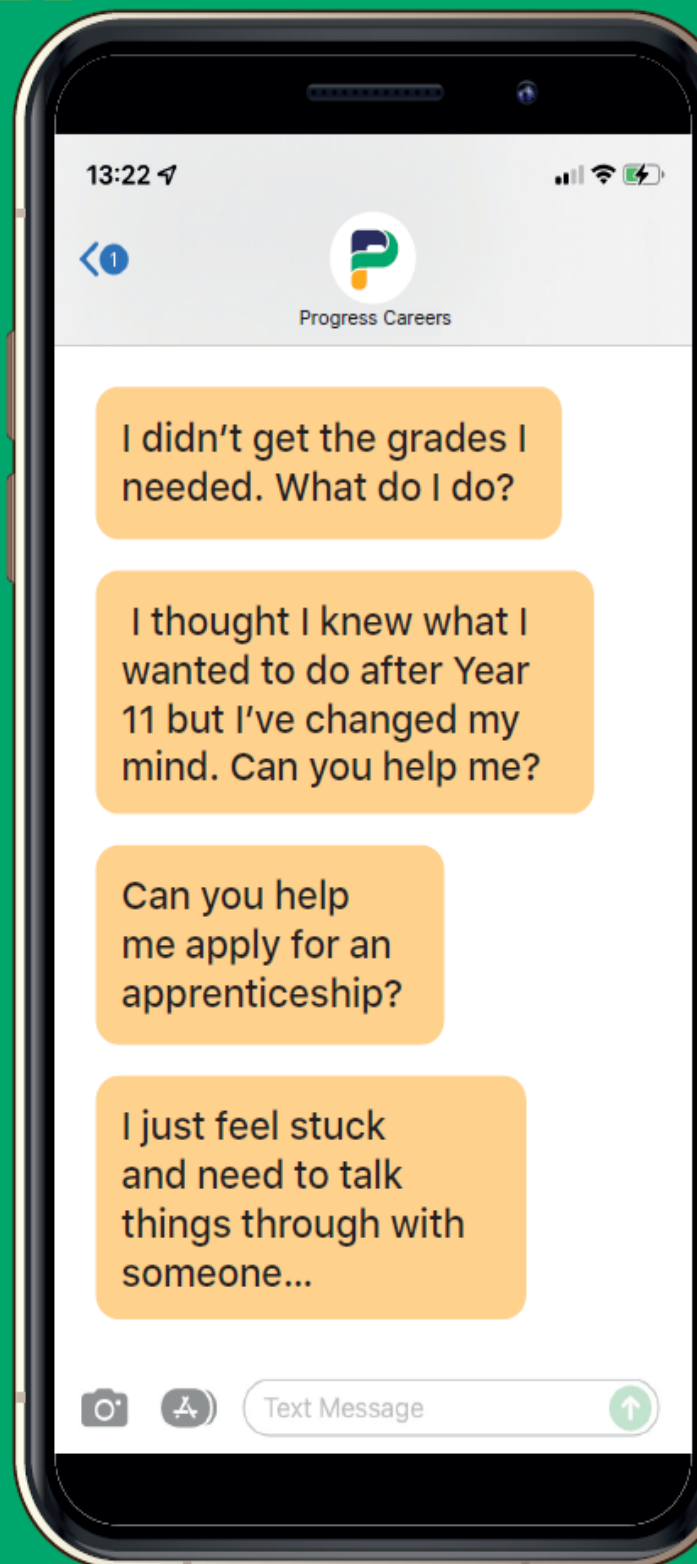
