DIGITAL AND ONLINE DONATIONS TO OUR LADY AND ALL SAINTS: Thank you to those parishioners, and visitors, who have recently either used the electronic donation machine at St Philip Neri or the QR code to contribute to the parish. I’m sure you will agree it is not complicated.....

The intention is to have this electronic access to provide an additional way of giving to the weekly collection for the increasing number of people who don’t carry cash (these are in the main ‘younger’ people). It will work alongside our current method of collections – there is no need to change the way you currently give.

Either scan the code [below] on your smart phone or try the machine if you are in St Philip Neri. It is installed on a corner unit next to the walkway to the hall.

The machine is very easy to use but if you have questions please raise them with your steward who should be able to answer.....

The first time a person uses their card to donate, they are asked if they wish to gift aid the amount. If you are a tax payer we encourage this. The process takes less than 1 minute to complete.....

Name; House number (not address); Post Code; Email address ...That’s it!..

Any future donations will be automatically gift aided and take 5 seconds to donate.
