JULY 2024 PRAYER PREPARING FOR Theme: Displaced Peoples

Scripture – "There are many rooms in my Father's house"

Every year, millions of people are forced to leave their homes due to conflict, violence, human rights violations, persecution, disasters, and the impacts of climate change. The number of forcibly displaced persons reached unprecedented heights in 2023, calling for increased humanitarian assistance.

By the end of June 2023, 110 million people were displaced worldwide, while UNHCR projects that there will be more than 130 million forcibly displaced persons in 2024. Around 52% of all these refugees originated from only 3 countries: Syria, Ukraine, and Afghanistan. The EU is the leading international donor in situations of forced displacement. Displacement lasts 20 years on average for refugees and more than 10 years for most IDPs.

Lord Jesus, give us more of your compassion for the plight of displaced persons, soften our hearts to their situation, and help us follow your lead in seeking justice and mercy on their behalf. We pray for an end to the wars, poverty and human rights abuses that drive desperate people to become refugees in the first place. Amen

DIGITAL AND ONLINE DONATIONS TO OUR LADY AND ALL SAINTS: Thank you to those parishioners, and visitors, who have recently either used the electronic donation machine at St Philip Neri or the QR code to contribute to the parish. I'm sure you will agree it is not complicated......

The intention is to have this electronic access to provide an additional way of giving to the weekly collection for the increasing number of people who don't carry cash (these are in the main 'younger' people). It will work alongside our current method of collections – there is no need to change the way you currently give.

Either scan the code [below] on your smart phone or try the machine if you are in St Philip Neri. It is installed on a corner unit next to the walkway to the hall.

The machine is very easy to use but if you have questions please raise them with your steward who should be able to answer.....

The first time a person uses their card to donate, they are asked if they wish to gift aid the amount. If you are a tax payer we encourage this. The process takes less than 1 minute to complete.....
