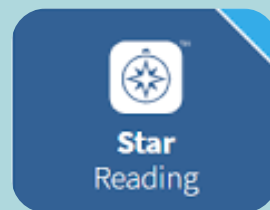
Library Books

We have already seen incredible results with pupils making rapid progress which is fantastic. We look forward to continuing to support our students to ensure that all pupils leave our school as confident readers.

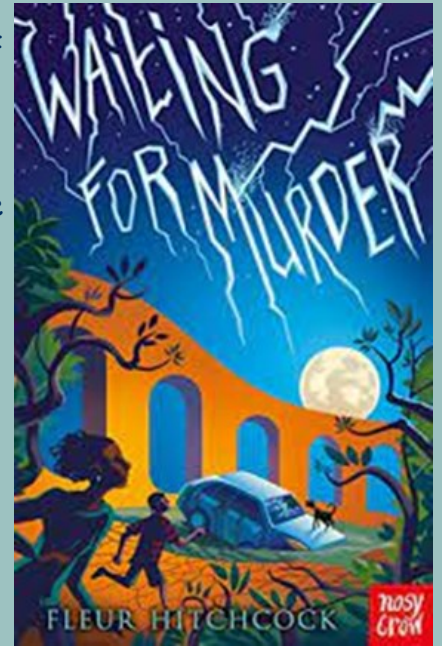


Bookbuzz

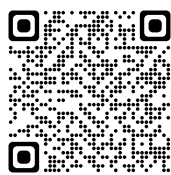
Reading Diet

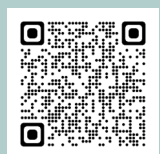
