


How do I give and receive HOPE?

The "most beautiful gift" the Catholic Church and its members can give the world is a reason to live with hope. The Christian cannot be satisfied with having hope; he or she must also radiate hope, be a sower of hope......The Holy Spirit is the evergushing source of Christian hope. In the Letter to the Romans, St. Paul says, "May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, so that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.

Hope is not "a passive virtue, which merely waits for things to happen, rather, it is a supremely active virtue that helps make them happen." Christian hope should be

shared "with gentleness and reverence," as the First Letter of Peter says, "because it is not so much the strength of the arguments that will convince people, but rather the love that we know how to put in them. This is the first and most effective form of evangelization."
