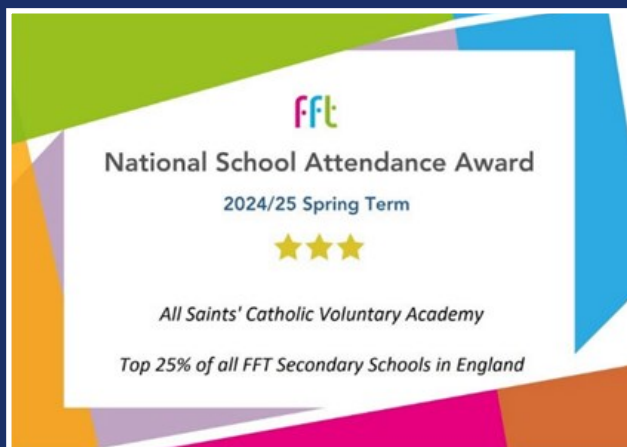
Attendance

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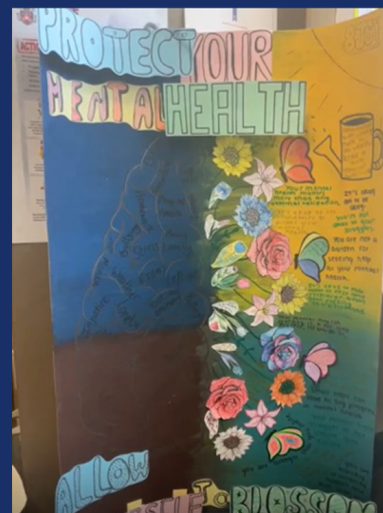

Mental Health and Wellbeing

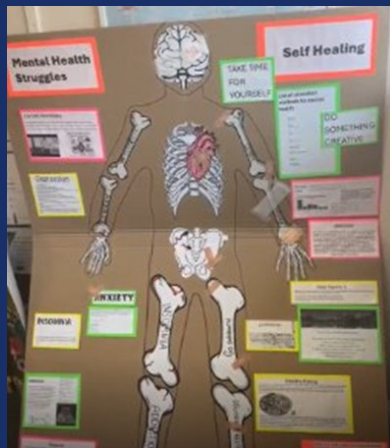

ECO Stewards

Eco stewards:

As part of our student Stewardship, we have recruited a team of students to become Eco stewards. They meet week and following an audit the students have started working on 3 main projects:

- **School garden** – planting a wide range of fruit and vegetables, to include, rhubarb, potatoes, leeks, parsnips, gooseberries and sunflowers.
- **Bug hotels and wild flower meadow** – planting wild flower seeds in an area of the field to encourage bees' to pollenate and creating bug hotels with wood and bricks.
- **Litter picking and recycling** – we have a whole school rota, where each tutor group spends one tutor time litter picking and finding plastic bottles to recycle



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Berlin visit

History and Languages students have recently enjoyed a visit to Berlin, visiting Bebelplatz, site of the infamous 1933 Nazi book burning, Sachsenhausen concentration camp, the iconic Olympic Stadium, which was originally built for the 1936 Olympics, the interactive DDR museum, the Berlin Wall Documentation Centre, the East Side Gallery and Checkpoint Charlie.

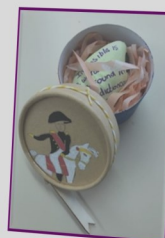

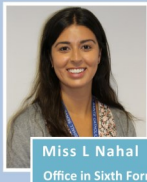
