Students will be given an appointment slip and they will need to seek appointments from their teachers. Please let your child know when you would like them to make their appointments in reference to the timings listed above. The event will be busy, and we would advise that only guardians and students attend to support the smooth running of the evening.

### **During the Evening- \*Important\***

Before you attend the event, please make sure you have a copy of the times of your appointments, the subject name and staff member's name, ensuring that the information on the sheet from your child is legible.

On arrival at All Saints', please make your way to the Dining Room in order to sign in. There will be a number of displays indicating the locations of different departments. Please ensure that you are waiting at the correct teacher at the correct time. The appointments will be **four** minutes long and the appointment begins at the allotted time of booking. The appointment cannot be extended; when the school bell is sounded, the appointment will draw to a close and parents and guardians should move to the next appointment.

These arrangements are in response to parental feedback about wait times and to support staff well-being.
