
OUR INTENT: A SPIRAL OF DEEPER

Key Message:


Our curriculum revisits core Catholic themes annually, building knowledge with increasing depth and complexity.

SKILL DEVELOPMENT: YEAR-BY-YEAR FOCUS

Years 7-8: FOUNDATIONS

Goal Understand core biblical and theological concepts.

Skills Knowledge recall, basic comprehension, identifying key narratives.

Years 9: CONNECTION

Goal Link Christ's mission and the sacraments to contemporary ethical issues.

Skills Analysis, making thematic connections, introductory ethical reasoning.

Years 10-11: APPLICATION

Goal Apply Catholic moral teachings to complex issues and engage with other world religions.

Skills Critical thinking, advanced ethical analysis, interfaith dialogue, exam preparation.
